Dear Brothert,

Your letter addressed to Sister White at Washington was forwarded to her at her home in St. Helena and received a few days ago. Several such letters have come to her and she has always advised that so far as possible our people should deal with such matters as they would wish other churches to deal with them, were they so situated that they had to secure some other church in which to worship while building one of their own. She has always advised that it would be well to have the denomination understand that seventh-day Adventists as a body would not feel free to let any denomination have the use of their churches for the purpose of holding festivals or any of these things that they as a body discountenance. But for religious services such as your church as a church hold, I do not see that there could be any objection to your letting another denomination use it.
